Glass Cutting Begins



Blues and Oranges...



Clear Glass "eyes"... will be painted later



More colors of glass added



Painted line work defines the "eyes" of peacock feathers



Glass pieces must fit pattern perfectly





The pattern is filling in...



More pieces added...



All glass for feathers has been cut and placed...



Painting of "eyes" begins



Painting of the peacock body




Peacock "eyes" checked before kiln-firing the paint



The "eyes" are removed from the kiln... beautiful colors!



Copper foiling begins...



Each tiny piece must be foiled then refitted



Copper foiling almost complete



The painted eyes are added



The WPCC nameplate is fitted



All the pieces are laid out



Tack soldering begins



Tack-soldered segment close-up



Sister Diane continues to tack solder



Tack soldering complete



Full soldering in process



Soldered piece examined before leading the edge
